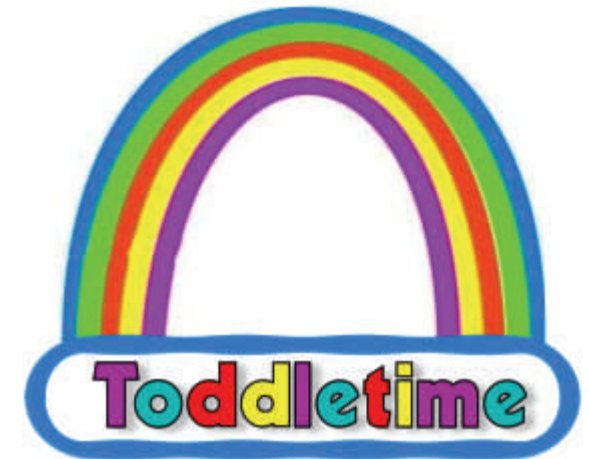

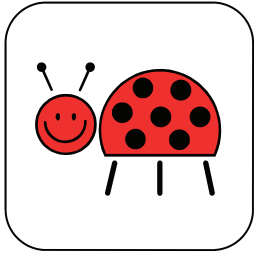

# Welcome to Toddletime

## Information for parents and carers



Toddletime is an informal baby and toddler group who meet every Tuesday morning at Wath library community room. We are run on a voluntary basis, and rely purely on the support of Parents and Carers who attend.

As a group we aim to offer friendly, relaxed and informal sessions where Parents and Carers can bring their babies and young children.

We are an inclusive group who aim to treat everyone with honesty, fairness and respect. We offer a warm welcome to everyone — Mums, Dads, Grandparents and Carers, regardless of age, gender, religion or physical ability. Please feel free to drop in at any session, we do not run a list at present.

We ask for a small voluntary contribution of £1.00 which helps to buy new toys, equipment, drinks and snacks. Toddletime do not profit from any monies received from this contribution.

## What do you do?

Toddletime run lots of different activities and provide toys for the children who attend. These include:

- Baby toys and a soft matted play area for our youngest members to play on, and toys for toddlers.
- Dressing up clothes and musical instruments.
- Arts, crafts and seasonal themed sessions throughout the year, which include painting, drawing and play dough etc.



And:

- Each week, at the end of each session, we provide healthy snacks and drinks. Usually these will be sandwiches and fruit, with milk or water.
- **Rhyme Time** (*songs and rhymes*), runs from 11.00am-11.30am.

We also have a great Christmas party and visit from father Christmas. A professional photographer and the **Book People** (*discounted books*), visit throughout the year.

Guest speakers may attend occasionally. (fire safety, dental hygienist etc) - Please speak to Liz or Annemarie if you feel there is any information which may benefit the group.

(Donations of clean toys, books and baby equipment are appreciated).
